

SCHEDULE 6

AGREEMENT TO PROCESS CROWN ROYALTY BITUMEN

FEEDSTOCK REQUIREMENTS

1. GENERAL

1.1 Capitalized Terms

Capitalized terms used in this Schedule have the definitions as set out in the Agreement to Process Crown Royalty Bitumen (the “**Processing Agreement**”) entered into between Alberta Petroleum Marketing Commission and North West Redwater Partnership.

1.2 Processing Agreement Reference

This Schedule is referenced in Sections 1.3 and 3.3 of the Processing Agreement.

1.3 Feedstock Requirements

The Base Crown Supply must meet the following quality parameters:

- (a) the general quality specifications applicable to each of the Feeder Pipelines onto which such of the Base Crown Supply will be delivered, as such specifications may exist from time to time;
- (b) in the absence of the requirements set out in section 1.3(a) of this Schedule, then the Enbridge pipeline quality specifications as they may exist from time to time and as currently specified through section 4 of the “*Enbridge Rules and Regulations for the Transportation of Crude Petroleum*”; and
- (c) unless the Processor otherwise permits, must not contain either of the following:
 - (i) blends with olefinic diluents; or
 - (ii) mined bitumen extracted through a naphthenic process such that it has high ultrafine clay content.
